



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/795-6

In the Matter of land known as the Greenway,
Trebtherick, St Minver, Cornwall

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 532 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by (1) Objection No. X796 made by the Duchy of Cornwall and noted in the Register on 28 April 1972, (2) Objection No. X1028 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 19 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 16 January 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr K G Wherry representing Trebtherick House Owners Association ("the Association") and St Minver Lowlands Parish Council, Mr J R Hickish representing the Duchy of Cornwall and Miss J Norris representing the National Trust.

The registration was made on the application of the Association. The Objections related only to separate parts of the land, the ground in each case being that the part in question was not common land at the date of registration. This was accepted by the Association and accordingly I confirm the registration with the modification that the two parts be excluded from the land.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
