



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/843

In the Matter of Land near Iregurthy,  
St. Austell, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.625 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X60A made by the former Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 9 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 26 June 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, but before the hearing I received a request signed by the Secretary of the Ramblers' Association, the applicant for the registration, not to confirm it.

Therefore I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
