



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/870-871

In the Matter of Larrick Common LezantDECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.628 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.383 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the the dispute at Bodmin on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill who appeared for the County Council.

This application was heard together with Reference No. 868-869 which related to an application to register the same area as common land. Mr Gill informed me that all parties concerned had reached agreement which included the withdrawal of this application.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
