



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL.401 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 27 February 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr C Nicholls, Solicitor, on behalf of the National Trust, the applicant for the conflicting registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of H R H Charles, Prince of Wales, Duke of Cornwall, the applicant for the registration.

However, since I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land Section of the Register Unit, my only course is to refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
