



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.6/D/4

In the Matter of Mill Pond,  
Lanivet, Cornwall.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 179 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.X 24 made by the County Council and noted in the Register on 14th July 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 13th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr J.Underwood, the Clerk of the Lanivet Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

The registration has been modified under regulation 8 of the Commons Registration (Objections and Maps) Regulations 1968 by the exclusion of part of the land comprised in the Register Unit pursuant to an application by the Parish Council. This modification in fact meets the Objection, but since the grounds of the Objection are that the whole of the land was not common land at the date of the registration, the Objection still technically survives, having only been met in part by the modification. However, since the Objector does not now contend that there should be any further modification of the registration I confirm the registration in the form in which it now stands in the Register.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
