DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and all the Entries in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 291 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No X 111A made by Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 15 July 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 15 July 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill on behalf of the Cornwall County Council. This Objection No X 111A was made by the County Council pursuant to Section 5(3) of the Act of 1965. The County Council did not now persist in its Objection and I therefore confirm the Entry at No 1 in the Land Section. I adjourn consideration of all the Entries in the Rights Section for the reasons given in my note attached to my decision on Unit No CL. 159.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
