



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/125-127

In the Matter of Piece of land
at Craddock Moor, St Cleer



DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and all the Entries in the Rights Section of Register Unit No CL. 461 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No X137A made by Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 16 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 15 July 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill on behalf of the County Council which made its objection pursuant to Section 5(3) of the Act of 1965. The County Council did not at this stage persist with its Objection and for this reason I confirm the Entry at No 1 in the Land Section and I adjourn for further consideration all the Entries in the Rights Section for the reasons given in my note attached to my decision on Unit No CL. 159.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
