



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/401-404

In the Matter of Pinsla Downs,  
Cardinham, Cornwall

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 256 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by (i) Objections No. X334 and X335 made by R H Bate and noted in the Register on 19 March 1971, (ii) Objections No. X359 and X360 made by the Trustees of the Will of Thomas Henry Tonkin and noted in the Register on 30 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 17 January 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr R H Bate.

The registration as common land was made pursuant to an application to register rights of common: Entry No. 7 is now the only registered right, and the successor to the applicant for its registration has withdrawn the claim to the right. Accordingly I shall uphold the Objections and refuse to confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
