



In the Matter of Porthallow Beach,  
St Keverne, Cornwall

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 2 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 378 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. K1213 and K1214 both made by Amalgamated Roadstone Corporation Limited and noted in the Register on 15 November 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 13 June 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill of the Registration Authority and by Mr R J Stillwell, Solicitor, representing Mr J Richards.

The registration in the Land Section was made in consequence of the application by Mr J Richards to register a right to take stones and gravel (Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section). There has been received a letter dated 30 May 1979 from the Objector (now Aney Roadstone Corporation Ltd) withdrawing the Objections.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 4 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
