

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 206/D/518 - 519

In the Matter of Predennack Wollas, Mullion Commyall (No. 3)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.CL.488 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. X550 made by Mr L Mitchell and noted in the Register on 28 March 1972 and the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the same section of the register unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 1 March 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P F Ryder, Solicitor, on behalf of the ObjectTor, who was also the applicant for the conflicting registration. Mr Ryder informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection or to support the conflicting registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
