



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/520

In the Matter of Predennack Wollas, Mullion,
Cornwall, (NO.4)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.CL.498 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No 1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 1 March 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P F Ryder, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr E Mitchell, the applicant for the registration, who informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
