



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/808

In the Matter of the piece of land called
Trewint for Altarnun

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos 1-6 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL.231 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X321 made by Mr R Jasper and noted in the Register on 15 February 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr P M Hewlitt of Messrs. Parnell and Co., Solicitors of Launceston who appeared for Mr Wadge and Mr R Jasper two of the applicants for rights and for Mr W Jasper the Objector.

Mr Hewlitt informed me that the parties had agreed to ask me to confirm the registration with certain modifications. The application for registration in the Village Green Section had been withdrawn.

For these reasons I confirm the registration in the Land Section and I also confirm Entry Nos 1, 4 and 5 in the Rights Section with the following modifications:-

| (iii) at Entry 5 | '8 head of cattle or 8 ponies or 30 sheep' for' 13 head of cattle or 13 ponies or 65 sheep' |

I refuse to confirm entry nos 2, 3 and 6 in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
