



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference no. 206/D/1062-1063

In the matter of the tract of Land  
of about 1235 acres called Cardinham Moor  
and Fore Downs, Cardinham.

**DECISION**

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL.137 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No.115 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.137 in the Register of Common Land.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 10 December 1996. The hearing was attended by Mr Wilson of Cornwall County Council the Registration Authority. The conflict consists in the fact that part of the dominant land of Rights Entry No.115 is also registered as part of the Common. The owner of that land, Mr Laurie Smith, by his solicitors wrote to say that he has no objection to the deletion of the land in question (hatched black on the Notice of Reference) from the Supplemental map referred to in Rights Entry No.115, and I adopt this suggestion and will direct the Cornwall County Council to amend the Supplemental Map accordingly.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
