

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Treskilling Downs, Luxulyan, Cornwall (No.2)

## Decision

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.626 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No.X1436 made by Mr P S Rasleigh and noted in the Register on 4 December 1972, and Objection No.X1151 made by Tehidy Minerals Ltd and also noted in the Register on 4 December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 25 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr E G Church, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance on behalf of the Objectors, but I gave leave to Mr P L Milln, Chartered Surveyor, to address me on behalf of English Clays Lovering Pochin and Co. Ltd, the successor in title of Tehidy Minerals Ltd.

For the reasons given in my decision in <u>In the Matter of Treskilling Downs</u>, <u>Luxulyan (No.1)</u> (1980) Ref. No.206/D/831-832 I am satisfied that Mr Church has made out his case.

Therefore I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
