



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.206/D/52

In the Matter of Trewellard Common,  
St.Just, Cornwall (No.2).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.2 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL 699 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.X 996 made by Mrs M.Cuddy and noted in the Register on 24th May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 11th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr D.J.Thurley, the applicant for the registration at Entry No.1 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit. The St.Just and Pendeen Old Cornwall Society, the applicant for the registration the subject of this dispute, was not represented, and the Objector did not appear and was not represented.

There being no evidence in support of the application for this registration, the registration could only be confirmed if the registration in the Rights Section of the Register Unit were confirmed. For the reasons given in my decision in In the Matter of Trewellard Common, St.Just (No.1) (1975) Reference Nos.206/D/53-54, I have refused to confirm that registration, and it therefore follows that I must refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
