COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/872-875

In the Matter of Wainhouse Corner Common,
St. Gennys

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.527 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X140 made by Mr J Cory and noted in the Register on 29 May 1970 and by Objection No. X160 made by the Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 3 July 1970. and as to the Registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of the same Register Unit in the same Register occasioned by Entry No. 2 in the said Ownership Section and vice versa.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J Cory in person and Mr Gill for the County Council. St. Gennys Parish Council did not appear. Mr Gill said that the objection of the County Council had been met by a modification of the Register Plan and was withdrawn.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration in the Land Section of the said Register Unit but I make no order as to costs.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
