Dalston, Cumbria (No. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 210 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 106 made by Mrs. M E Thompson and noted in the Register on 4 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 7 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P W Pickles, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. There was no appearance on behalf of the Church Commissioners for England, the applicants for the registration.

Since by my decision in In the Matter of a Freestone Quarry near Gill, Dalston (No. 1) (1981), Ref. No. 262/D/341 I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit, it follows that I must refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
