



In the Matter of A Public Clay Pit and Memorial Waste,  
Mooklane Foot, near Dalston, Cumbria (No. 2)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 208 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 9 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P Rigby, solicitor, on behalf of the Church Commissioners for England, the applicants for the conflicting registration, and by Mr A F Cope, the Clerk of the Dalston Parish Council, the applicant for the registration.

Mr Rigby informed me that he was instructed not to support the conflicting registration.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration as being undisputed.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
