



In the Matter of A Public Watering Place and
Public Clay Pit near Lakerigg, Dalston,
Cumbria (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 205 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 8 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr A F Cope, Clerk of the Dalston Parish Council, the applicant for the conflicting registration. There was no appearance on behalf of the Church Commissioners for England, the applicants for the registration, but Mr Cope informed me that he had received a telephone message that they wished to "withdraw" their application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
