

In the Matter of Birkbeck Falls Common, Orton, Cumbria (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 4 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 9 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 2/135 made by the Crosby Ravensworth Commoners Committee and noted in the Register on 10 February 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 30 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J T Relph, the Secretary of the Commoners Committee. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr T Dodd, the applicant for the registration, but Mr Relph informed me that it had been agreed that the grazing rights should be reduced to 100 sheep, 6 head of cattle, and 3 ponies.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications; namely, the substitution of "6" for "12" and "3" for "6".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in toint of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
