



In the Matter of Blencarn Fell,
Culgaith, Cumbria (NO.1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 7 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.323 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 133 made by Mr J K Stamper and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 31 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr C V Hodgson, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr T M Arnison, Solicitor on behalf of the Objector.

The registration is of the right to graze 50 sheep and followers and 20 breeding mares with foals. Mr Mellor informed me that it had been agreed that 4 horses should be substituted for the breeding mares with foals.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the modification necessary to give effect to the agreement.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
