



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.262/D/615-616

In the Matter of Cragfell Parish Quarry  
Ennerdale and Kinniside, Copeland B

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section and Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No.CL.106 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 68 made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and noted in the Register on 29 September 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitehaven on 22 July 1981. The hearing was attended by Miss Braddock, Solicitor, appearing on behalf of the Objector: by Mr Rawlings, Chairman of and representing Ennerdale and Kinniside Parish Council, the applicant for registration in the land and the ownership sections, and by Mr T Greer of the Registration Authority.

The Objection is in terms to all three sections - Land, Rights and Ownership. There are no entries in the Rights Section and the Objection to the Land Section registration was not pursued, it having been agreed that the registration of the Parish Council in the Ownership Section should be confirmed. Accordingly I confirm both registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
