



In the Matter of Crosby Ravensworth Fell,
Crosby Ravensworth, Orton and Shap Rural,
Cumbria (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 4 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 10 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1/10 made by the Crosby Ravensworth Commoners Association and noted in the Register on 8 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 24 April 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J T Relph, the Secretary of the Objectors. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the applicant for the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
