



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 262/D/59

In the Matter of Flatt Village Green,
Kirkbampton, Cumbria

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 93 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 152 made by Kirkbampton Parish Council and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Cockermouth on 22 May 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard but on 23 May 1979 Mr J W Holliday, the Chairman of the Parish Council, attended. The registration in the Land Section was made on the application of Mr W Brownrigg who is also provisionally registered as owner in the Ownership Section. The Objection is to the registrations in both Land and Ownership Sections and the stated grounds of objection are that the land at the time of registration was not in the ownership of the claimant.

Mr Holliday informed me that the objection to registration in the Land Section was withdrawn, but not the objection to registration in the Ownership Section. The Reference before me relates only to the former, and the Objection in this respect having been withdrawn, I confirm the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
