



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 262/D/78

In the Matter of Glenridding Common,
Patterdale, Cumbria (No. 3)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 3 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 101 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 22 April 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr P Watson, the Land Agent of the National Trust, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 3, and by Mr C J Chapman, Solicitor, on behalf of the Lake District Special Planning Board, the successor in title of the applicants for the conflicting registration.

Mr Watson and Mr Chapman informed me that it was agreed that the land the subject of both registrations was in the joint ownership of the National Trust and the Planning Board.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification; namely, the addition in column 3 after the word "Ambleside" of the words "and the Lake District Special Planning Board National Park Office, Kendal in equal undivided half shares".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
