

In the Matter of Land between the Road in Stainton Village and Keld Head, Dacre, Cumbria (No. 1)

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No CL 236 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumoria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 167 made by the Dacre Parish Council and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 31 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, solicitor, on behalf of the Stainton Jury, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objector, but the Clerk of the Parish Council informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by a letter dated 6 October 1980 that the Objection was "withdrawn".

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
