



In the Matter of Land between the Road in Stainton
Village and Keld Head, Dacre, Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 236 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 166 made by the Dacre Parish Council and Objection No. 126 made by Mr H Noblett and both noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 31 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, solicitor, on behalf of the Stainton Jury, the applicant for the registration, and Mr Noblett appeared in person.

Mr Mellor informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
