



In the Matter of Longdale Fell, Orton,  
Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 26 and 27 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 42 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos. 2-23, 25 and 29-31 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 23 April 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J A Hesmondhalgh, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr J Bland, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 26, by Mr R A Sterling, of counsel, on behalf of Mr J Bland, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 27 and by Mr T A Hodges, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr R T W Hewetson, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 18. There was no appearance by or on behalf of any of the other applicants for the conflicting registrations.

Mr Hesmondhalgh stated that he was instructed to resolve the conflict so far as the registration at Entry No. 26 was concerned by asking for that registration to be modified by the deletion of the word "sole", and Mr Sterling stated that he was instructed not to support the registration at Entry No. 27.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration at Entry No. 26 with the following modification, namely, the deletion of the word "sole"; and I refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No. 27.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
