

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 262/D/602

In the Matter of Lowick Common, Lowick, Cumbria

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL 39 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 24 made by Mr M Newton and noted in the Register on 4 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Kendal on 10 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr R F Hart-Jackson, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr and Mrs R W Hind, the successors in title of Ms E M Mather, Ms N Mather, and Mr J A Mather, the applicants for the registration and Mr M S Graham, Solicitor, on behalf of Messrs Vickers and Hine, the successors in title of the Objector.

The only matter in dispute between the parties was the ownership of a very small outbuilding to the north of the basket works at the north-eastern end of the land comprised in the Register Unit. Mr Hart-Jackson and Mr Graham informed me that it had been agreed that this building did not belong to Mr and Mrs Hind.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification, namely, the addition after the words in column 4 of the words "excluding the building shown within the circle coloured red on the plan marked 'G.D.S.1' attached to the notice of the final disposal of this registration'.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
