



In the Matter of Mean Moss, ^SHeathergill,
Cumbria (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 232 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 119 made by the Heathergill Parish Council and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 7 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr J Mawson, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. Mr Mawson informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
