



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 262/D/73

In the Matter of Morland Village Green,  
Morland, Eden District, Cumbria.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No VG 46 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cumbria (formerly Westmorland) County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 2/31 made by Mr Tom Herbert Wilkinson Atkinson and noted in the Register on 18 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 25 April 1979. At the hearing (1) Morland Parish Council (the registration was made on their application) were represented by Mr D Mellor, solicitor with Little & Shepherd, Solicitors of Penrith; and (2) Mrs Edith May Kitching of Mersey Cott, Morland, and Miss Mary Elsie Atkinson of 1 Coney Cottage, Almshoebury, Hitchin, Herts as executors of Mr T H W Atkinson (he died 24 February 1975) were represented by Mrs J King solicitor with Harrison Grainger & Reed, Solicitors of Penrith.

Mrs King who produced the probate dated 16 May 1975 of the will of Mr T H W Atkinson, said that the objection was withdrawn. Accordingly, I confirm the registration without any modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
