



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 262/D/314

In the Matter of Public Watering
Place, near Seascale How, Seascale

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 311 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 197 made by Messrs Lamb and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitehaven on 25 November 1980. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard, other than Mr Greer of the Registration Authority. The registration was made on the application of Seascale Parish Council: there are no entries in the Rights and Ownership Sections. The stated grounds of the Objection are somewhat cryptic viz. "None Existent", and the section of the Register to which the Objection appears to relate is 'Ownership', not 'Land'. In the absence of any evidence to explain or support the Objection, I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
