



In the Matter of Rectory Moss, Angerton, Cumbria.

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Rectory Moss, Angerton being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 115 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Kendal on ~~30 March 1982.~~

At the hearing Mr C J Slater appeared in person.

The land the subject of the reference was conveyed to Mr Slater and his wife by a conveyance made 4 April 1968 between (1) Doris Wilson (2) Charles Joseph Slater and Joan Slater his wife.

On this evidence I am satisfied that Mr and Mrs Slater are the owners of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Cumbria County Council, as registration authority, to register them as the owners of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
