

In the Matter of Sandside Marsh, Angerton and Kirkby Ireleth, Cumbria, (No. 3)

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the regstration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 117 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos. 268 and 270 made by the late Mr W Coward and Objection No. 272 made by the Kirkby Ireleth Commoners Association, and all noted in the Register on 10 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Kendal on 10 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr C Aitchison, the agent of the Holker Estate Trust, the applicant for the registration, Mr J Coward, the son of Mr W Coward and Mr J W Curwen, the Chairman of Commoners Association.

Mt Aitchison informed me that it was not desired to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
