



In the Matter of Sandside Marsh, Angerton
and Kirkby Irethleth, Cumbria, (No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 117 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos. 206, 267 and 269 made by the late Mr W Coward and Objection No. 271 made by the Kirkby Irethleth Commoners Association, and all noted in the Register on 10 Marsh 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Kendal on 10 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr M J Graham, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr J W Hinde, the applicant for the registration, Mr J Coward, the son of Mr W Coward, and Mr J W Curwen, the Chairman of the Commoners Association.

Mr Graham informed me that he was instructed not to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
