## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 179 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG 65 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 8 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr W Watson, a member of the Wetheral Parish Council, the applicant for both the registration and the conflicting registration.

Mr Watson informed me that the Parish Council did not wish to support the registration.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
