



In the Matter of The Eastern Portion of  
Martindale Common, Martindale, Cumbria (No. 4)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 6 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 3 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 2/175 made by Mrs S M McCosh and noted in the Register on 18 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 30 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr W H Parkin, the applicant for the registration, but Mr Mellor informed me that it had been agreed that the grazing rights should be reduced to 500 sheep, 20 head of cattle, and 10 ponies.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications: namely, the substitution of "500" for "800", and "20" for "50".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
