



In the Matter of The Grune, Skinburness, Silloth,
Cumbria (NO.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL.30 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objections Nos. 209 and 210 made by Mr J T Wills and both noted in the Register on 4 August 1972 and the conflicts between the registrations in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 27 March 1984. The hearing was attended by Mr S Wallis, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr J S Harrison, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1, and Mrs J Littleton, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 4, and by Mr P W Pickles, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr A E B Standish, Mr G M Kerr and Mr R K Lockhead, the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 2. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr W S Rontledge, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 3, or the Objector.

Having refused to confirm the registration in the Land Section of the Register Unit, it follows that I must refuse to confirm these registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
