



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 262/U/436

In the Matter of the land known as Carr Bed
Marsh, Rockcliffe

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Carr (or Car) Bed Marsh, Rockcliffe being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 444 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cumberland County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Carlisle on 18 December 1981.

Mr P W Pickles of Messrs Hough, Halton and Soal, Solicitors of Carlisle appeared for Mr J Read and Mr H K Hughes of Messrs Dobinson, Turner and Hughes, Solicitors of Carlisle appeared for the other applicants in the Rights Section. None of these applicants claimed ownership.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
