In the Matter of the Public Watering Place near Madam House and Town Head, Dalston

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. CL 202 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cumberland County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 222 made by Dalston Parish Council and noted in the Register on 21 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 18 December 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P W Pickles on behalf of the Church Commissioners and Mr A P Cope for the Parish Council. The state of the s

Mr Pickles withdrew the application made by the Church Commissioners. 

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
