



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Tracts of Open Fell,
Buttermere

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5, 8-12, 14-15 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 118 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cumberland County Council and is occasioned by Objections made by Messrs Edwin Thompson and Company and noted in the Register.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 30 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr G R Quigley of Messrs Waugh and Musgrave, Solicitors of Cockermouth appearing for the Trustees of the Melbreak Foxhounds and Mr A R Nobbs of Messrs Oglethorpe and Hough, Solicitors of Keswick who appeared for Mr P E Thompson, the successor to Mr T F G Alston (the applicant at Entry No. 15).

The objections has been withdrawn and I was invited to confirm all applications for rights except Entry No. 15. Subsequently I was informed by Mr Nobbs that his client's application should also be confirmed.

For these reasons I confirm the registration at all the Entries in the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
