



In the Matter of Uldale Fells, Ireby, Cumbria (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 9 (now 32) in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 46 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 507 made by Messrs Edwin Thompson & Co and noted in the Register on 20 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 10 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr A R Nobbs, solicitor, on behalf of Mr J M Ashburner, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance on behalf of the Objectors.

The original registration was of a right to graze 1000 sheep, but on 23 March 1971 Mr Ashburner applied for it to be modified to 572 sheep. The Objectors' agents informed Mr Nobbs's firm by a letter dated 6 November 1980 that in view of the amendment the Objection would be "withdrawn".

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
