



In the Matter of (1) The Village Green at the junction of Main Road and Stan hope Street and Dale Road (2) School Green at the junction of School Lane, Main Street and Quarry Hill (3) The Village Pound at Quarry Hill, Stanton-by-Dale in the County of Derby.

DECISION.

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of three pieces of land known as (1) Village Green (2) School Green and (3) the Village Pound being ⁽¹³⁾ ~~the part of the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 54~~ in the Register of Town and Village Greens maintained by the Derbyshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Derby on the 10 June 1980.

Mr F G Wheeler and Mrs J J Brown, Clerk and Chairwoman respectively of Stanton-by-Dale Parish Council, but neither they nor any other person gave evidence before me. *appeared before*

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Derbyshire County Council as registration authority, to register Stanton-by-Dale Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
