

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 208/U/70

In the matter of Nettles Mere, Taddington

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of the land described above being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL87 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Derbyshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the CommonsRegistration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference the Executors of Thomas W Smith claimed to be the freehold owners of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Matlock on 7 May 1980. At the hearing Mr W Smith, Chairman of Taddington Parish Council, appeared. He said that in the 18th century there was an award of the Mere, which is now dried up and is not maintained by the Parish Council.

On this eveidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioner Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
