

In the Matter of the piece of land known as The Triangle or Green opposite Shirland Church or Trunk Road A61 in the Parish of Shirland in the County of Darby

## <u>DECISION</u>

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as The Triangle or Green opposite Shirland Church being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 10 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Derbyshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons; Registration: Acts 1965, as the cowner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Chesterfield on 1 October 1980.

Mr W Beaumont a member of Shirland and Higham Parish Council appeared at the hearing but called no evidence.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
