



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 209/D/140

In the Matter of Beesands Green (part),  
Stokenham, Devon (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No. VG 28 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dartmouth on 20 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr S Tuckey, of Counsel, on behalf of Mr T J Honeywill and Mr T S Honeywill, the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 1. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Major A W Rainey, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 2, which relates only to a part of the land comprised in the Register Unit, which it was agreed should be excluded from the Register Unit.

In these circumstances it only remains for me to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
