



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Buceyhayes Common,
Stockland, Devon (No.1)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.8 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Devon County Council and are occasioned by Objection Nos.156 and 201 made by Mrs J.F.H. and Mr F.J. Shipp and both noted in the Register on 15th October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Exeter on 23rd October 1974. The hearing was attended by Mr P.A.J. Browne, solicitor, on behalf of the Devon County Council. Mrs and Mr Shipp did not appear and were not represented.

The land the subject of this reference was allotted by the Stockland Inclosure Award in the same way as the land the subject of my decision in In the Matter of Horner Hill, Stockland (No.1), (1974) No.209/D/1-3, and for the reasons there given I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1974 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
