## DECISION

hese disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land section of egister Unit No. VG. 63 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the evon County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 17 made by the Hon, Mrs H W ildmay-White and noted in the Register on 1 September 1970 and Objection No. 26 ade by the Parochial Church Council of Holbe $m{t}$ ton. and noted in the Register on 11 June 969.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dartmouth on 21 May 900. The hearing was attended by Mr J Hare. Solicitor, on behalf of :Mrs Mildmay-White. here was no appearance by or on behalf of Mrs M E Stacey, the applicant for the egistration, or on behalf of the Parochial Church Council, but in a letter dated <sup>o</sup> June 1971, addressed to the Clerk of the County Council Mrs Stacey stated that she greed to the registration being cancelled.

n these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.
