



In the Matter of Hentor Warren, Willings Wall Warren
Trowlesworthy Warren, Shaugh Moor, Wotter Common, The Ruts
and part of Crownhill Down, Shaugh Prior, Devon (No. 4)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 5 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 190 in the Registrar of Common Land maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the same section of the Register Unit.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Paignton on 25 January 1977. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard but before the hearing Mr J A F Macfarlane, the agent for the Roborough Estate Trustees, who applied for the registration at Entry No. 1 informed the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners in writing that on further search it had been found that the small area the subject of the conflict belonged to Mrs J E S Cobbold, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 5.

I therefore confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 2 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision at the High Court.
