



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 209/D/160-162

In the Matter of Orley Common, Torbryan, DevonDECISION

These disputes relate to the registrations at Entry Nos 4 and 5 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL.23 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Devon County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 305 made by Mr W E Adams and noted in the Register on 2 November 1970, Objection No. 641 made by Mr D H Ferens and noted in the Register on 23 November 1970, and Objection No. 373 made by Ms A G Bulley and also noted in the Register on 23 November 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 28 November 1972. The hearing was attended by Mr N Henson, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr Adams and Mr G Atkinson, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr C J Chudley, the successor in title of Ms Bulley. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr J F Stark, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 4, or Mr J C K McElderry, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 5.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm both registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
